Week: 2

Title: Being Orange - Feeling Different - Five Tactics

Opening Question(s):

"What do you remember about the comic we started reading last week?"

Thoughts:

"We are going to talk about the choice to be Orange. Spark knew that when he was green, he didn't feel as good as being Orange. When he started taking better care of himself and being kind to others, he became more and more Orange. What types of things can we do to become more Orange?

Action:

We are going to look at some trends and discuss which one best fits with the action. These actions are known to help others become more happy and healthy. They are color tactics."
